## **FAQ for Ft. Sutter PECG Fall Social**

**Why Two Social Events?** Our primary social event is bowling, laser tag, and arcade games at Country Club Lanes. To keep with the tradition of making our event appeal to the general membership, we are again offering the movie option (2 movie passes) as an alternative. There will be no blended options (bowling and movie tickets).

**What is the fee?** The fee is:

- Bowling Option: \$7 per person
- Movie Option: \$3 per person

Children 3 and under are free. The maximum number per party is 4. We are charging a fee this year so that we can offer this event to more members

**How do I sign up?** Sign-up is initiated on-line. Last day to sign-up using website link is September 1. Wait for a reply from Fort Sutter to ensure that we received your reservation and have confirmed that room is still available. After we respond, you can then send in the paper reservation form and a check to PECG HQ Address: Attn: Fort Sutter Section, 660 J St., Suite 445, Sacramento, CA 95814. We will send you a final confirmation when we receive your check. If you need to cancel, you must do so by September 12 to get a refund. We will maintain a waiting list to fill in for cancellations.

**Why is the charge for the bowling option higher than the movie option?** The movie option does not have the same dollar value as the bowling option. The bowling option is a per person option. In addition to the charge for food, the section pays for lane and shoe rental for each person. The bowling option also provides game tokens and laser tag. The movie option is just 2 tickets. Therefore, the charge per person is less than the bowling option.

**How will the activities be handled?** Participants will first check in. Your name must be on our list or you must have your final confirmation e-mail. Bowlers should check in early to eat at the café, get bowling shoes, and to reserve a lane by 3 pm. Color coded wrist bands will be given to distinguish those who choose to bowl from those who choose the movie option. Bowlers will be given vouchers for tokens and movie goers will be given movie passes. We have reserved enough lanes to allow bowlers to keep their lane for the entire time. If there is a shortage of lanes, we will check wrist bands. The bowling wrist bands will also allow entry to play laser tag. Laser tag will be available from 3 to 5 pm in 15 minute sessions. To give everyone a chance to play, your hand will be marked. A last call will be made before allowing repeat players.

**What kind of food is being served?** The Concourse Café will honor your wrist band privilege from 2:30-5 pm. The café serves breakfast items, sandwiches, salads, drinks, and snacks. You can order anything off the menu. There will also be a buffet table from 3-5 pm with finger foods (chips n salsa, peanuts, pretzels, salad, meat and cheese, bread trays, cookies and cakes, baby carrots and dressing). The buffet table will be kept stocked for the entire 2 hours. Alcohol is not included. Party hosts will be available to serve you at the bowling lanes. Gratuity fees are covered.

**Must I use up my game tokens by 5 pm?** No, you can come back and use your game tokens on another day
